



Environmental Policy

BK Nolte Contracts Limited is a designer, supplier and installer of high-quality kitchen and bedroom furniture to the trade and public based in Wrexham.

We are committed to achieving optimal levels of environmental performance. It is the ultimate responsibility of the Managing Director and all staff to ensure that the Environmental Management System (EMS) is fully implemented, documented and maintained, in order to aid our commitment to the prevention of pollution. We support the continual improvement and management of the system and are committed to compliance with legislation, best practice, and the Green Dragon Standard.

The organisation shall commit to protecting the natural environment from damage and degradation from its services at all times.

We source our materials from sustainable markets in accordance with our purchasing policy which supports schemes such as the Programme for the Endorsement of Forest Certification (PEFC) and to use only Forest Stewardship Council (FSC) accredited companies.

We have installed an LED lighting system with sensors throughout head office.

We have started to replace company (diesel) cars with Hybrid vehicles.

We recognise our key impacts on the environment are as follows:

- Transportation of kitchens.
- Energy usage and paper use within head office.

We aim to always work towards and continually improve the following:

- Accreditation and support of the Fleet Operator Recognition Scheme (FORS) to assist us to reduce our impacts from transport.
- Minimise our waste and ensure it is diverted from landfill sites as much as possible.
- Reduce energy use and paper consumption within our head office and showrooms.

Following the list above we intend to fully comply with all legal and other requirements to which we subscribe and also to the requirements of health and safety regulations that may relate to our environmental aspects.

We aim to provide the framework for setting the environmental objectives and targets as follows:

- By consultation with appropriate external agencies, both locally, nationally and internationally.
- Periodically checking that our compliance is up to date by correspondence with those appropriate external agencies and by checking documentation.
- By consulting with our customers at the contract stage and delivering on agreed service levels.
- By discussion at EMS Management Review level.
- By maintaining our Silver FORS standard.

We endeavour to supply our EMS to our customers when contractually required. EMS matters are communicated to our organisation via involvement, notice boards and toolbox talks. This policy is also available to the public via our web page.
